US HISTORY: THE FAIRYTALE VERSION Sermon by Minister Angela Smith of COPE for February 23rd, 2020 (and beyond)

Europeans set sail for India and found a whole new continent they were not expecting now known as the Americas. Historically, it is suggested the aboriginal locals settled thousands of years before having traveled from Japan or Southeast Asia and had established their own territories, customs, and society. It was a time of conquest, colonization, and imperialism. The existing and established locals were ill-equipped to deal with the advanced militarism of the imperialists, but, there was hope. Some of the imperialists were fond of Priest John Ball, Protestantism, Plato's Republic, and the Magna Carta. They felt oppressed by the monarchies of Europe and joined forces with the remaining locals (a.k.a. American Indians), French dissenters, and settlers of all sorts from colonial times and decided to establish a new constitutional republic in the spirit of recognizing all human beings as equal in the eyes of the law where even President Ulysses S. Grant would one day be subject to arrest for violating traffic laws (speeding) in DC while President of the United States and allegations of corruption including things like Iran-Contra are televised, exposed, and the accused publicly questioned. And, then the spirit of the law resulted in amendments to the laws resulting in greater recognition of equality for all American Citizens.

For those unable to establish settlements themselves, willingness to relocate and travel the open road to unfamiliar places risking death, robbery, and at times even being trafficked for labor as a result of being misled and trusting those offering employment will keep their word while perhaps not being able to read or write so not understanding contracts signed which would suggest incompetence at law and result in being deemed incompetent or criminal and institutionalized in a fashion where you are likely to experience some labor trafficking or worse, was required then as now just to survive. But, the desperation involved in trying to survive and get basic needs met with some dignity while looking for gainful employment is extraordinarily challenging as many can imagine and worse yet for the orphaned or abandoned. And, relocating sounds so scary and requires having a lot of faith where such relocations in the past involved being trafficked, exploited, or otherwise abused. But, Americans have always taken the chance and many have died or succumbed to vice in the process. This is why I encourage everyone to see anyone tempting you to vice or vicious illegal misconduct as a "devil" that you exercise #TaoFu to reject by responding to said temptations with the correct corresponding virtue. See, as a creative construct without invoking notions of demonic

possession on either side, but rather realizing if you choose to commit a crime and can't afford a good defense attorney that you are going to be enslaved most likely by the Prison Industrial Complex and if you'd prefer not to be trafficked while criminals are made trustees to oversee you as a newcomer that for your own modest current freedom committing to Truth and Virtue is how best to protect yourself from being lured into a life of slavery through temptations to vice. So, figuring out which Virtues best address your situation is how to totally embrace and protect your own Freedom which is possibly the most important virtue second only to Truth and equal to Justice. If you Love (another virtue) Freedom, committing to Truth and Virtue is the best way to show it and Freedom has a way of affirming that through the Justice System. One could argue missing the point of Crocodile Dundee too. You could think of it in terms of a tween (10-year old) unsupervised at a grocery store that is bothering you in a manner that could be considered assault or menacing at law, perhaps malicious mischief, and as an adult or even other more reasonable tween, how you might respond to the threat or annoyance. If not, don't be a hypocrite and treat others the way you'd like to be treated. Did you graduate Kindergarten? Most people are familiar with the Golden Rule to assist in avoiding hypocrisy by the time they graduate Kindergarten." So, you can see at law where people doing such things would be deemed criminal or incompetent and end up in some form of institutionalized segregated congregate care where human trafficking is a known issue and sometimes authorized for the adjudicated.

So, if you are a Snow White, Cinderella, or even Jack of Beanstalk fame, what is your story? And, anyone attempting to prevent you from learning and impose ignorance while employing Machiavellian emotional/behavioral manipulation to train you like some nonhuman animal is also a devil and you rebel against their evil and learn anyway, that's why we have libraries and now the internet. Overcome the devils and villains in your life and refuse to become one. America awaits your welcome.
